Sample Sizes

Starting 1/1/18, the Marijuana Enforcement Division* determines minimum sample size that testing laboratories may accept. The sample size depends on the size of your harvest or batch, not the test being performed.

Each mandatory test for your batch may be performed on the *same* individual tagged sample. Please check all requested tests after clicking “*Submit for Testing*”.

For a terpene profile, we can take it from the same sample. Please request one by writing it on the Metrc tag.
